Sign up on the flower calendar on the bulletin board to honor or remember a loved one with flowers.

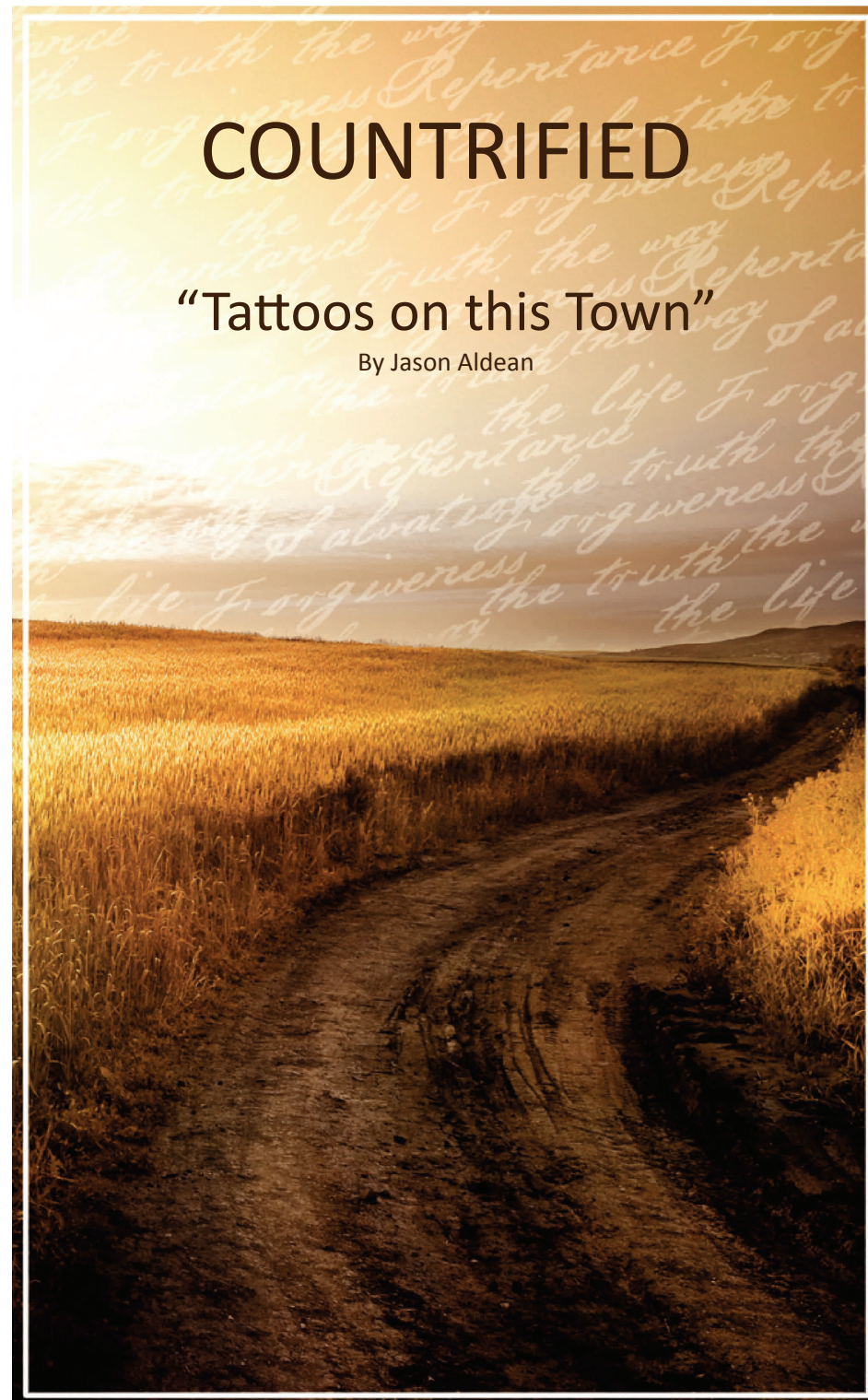
Put the name of who you are honoring and by whom (you) and make your check to David Brown for \$30 the week the flowers are at the altar.
